Postal Service Establishment in Fort Morgan

Through Rain, Sleet, Wind & Snow the postal motto could also have included swamp, wetlands and bayous because when the postal service finally came to Fort Morgan that had to be the determination of the carriers. William Gasque, a retiree Probate Judge of Baldwin County, who lived in Daphne AL was of Huguenot descent born on December 6, 1811 in the old town of St Stephens, Washington County AL. Judge Gasque held many positions in both Mobile and Baldwin counties from 1835 thru 1892. He never married and was the last survivor of his family. The Gasque post office was established in 1880. Perhaps the old post office at Gasque was named properly because all the people who carried the mail like Mr. Grim, Mr. Grahem, Mr. Galloway, Ms. Violet Nelson (postmaster until 1950), and Ms. Galloway (who took over the water route) came from the same cut of cloth serving their community.
