The Ft Morgan planning and zoning advisory committee met on Jun 28 and made the following recommendations to the county.

- \* Recommended approval of a variance to allow moving a residence onto the center of an adjacent lot and encroach on the side setbacks by six (6) inches
- \* Recommended denial of a request to build a residence inside a rear setback so a larger house could be built
- \* Recommended approval of a request to reconstruct a boat storage facility to its original height pre hurricane Sally. Also agreed that no additional parking was necessary pre hurricane parking was satisfactory
